

HORTON & WRAYSBURY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN
Steering Group meeting notes: Monday, February 15, 2016

Held at Wraysbury Village Hall, 2.30pm

1. Review of Workshop meeting :

At that meeting, EA representatives were present and discussions took place regarding the floodplain situations in the parishes and what might be able to be built given the constraints. Following that meeting, our consultant, John Slater, said it looked like there were hardly any identifiable sites in Wraysbury, and wondered whether Horton, which had less floodplain issues, might be able to take more housing.

BM said that Horton PC would be meeting tomorrow (Feb 16) and the matter would be raised.

2. Public Drop-in Session:

Agreed that Saturday, April 9, be set for the open day at Wraysbury Village Hall.

Suggested time, between 10am and 4pm. Steering Group members to be present, with possible shift arrangements.

Invitation leaflet to be designed and distributed to all households. Display stands needed - JG offered one that BS Bennett had (three-panelled) for use. Further discussions needed on what information should be displayed. John Slater had suggested it would be useful to have a large map of our area, and possibly the floodplain.

ML asked group members to look at the Hurley & Walthams pre-submission draft plan – particularly in regard to land-based policies – and offer suggestions as to how we might adapt for H&W and to bring to the next meeting.
